The prequalified firm must have unlimited status. Responsibilities of the professional consultant firm include, but are not limited to:

Required Scope of Services

- Development of plans for a downtown sidewalk enhancement project
- Preparation of specifications and bid documents
- Assuring compliance with Davis-Bacon Wage Rate guidelines
- On-site inspection of the construction activities

Estimated Schedule for Performance of Work

- Design Phase, Preliminary Engineering Plans Submission/Right-of-Way Acquisitions 9 months
- Construction Plans, Bidding 3 months
- Award Project, Begin/Complete Construction 12 months

All letters of interest must be received by the City of Parsons on or before 4:00 P.M. Wednesday, September 5, 2018. The letter of interest and qualifications shall indicate the scope of services to be completed by any sub-consultants. Invoices can be submitted monthly with percentage of work completed based upon an approved schedule of hourly rates. Invoices will be paid by city issued checks.

## Phase I Evaluation

For Phase I evaluations firms shall submit letters of interest with firm contact information including name, address and e-mail of primary contact. The letters of interest shall also include:

- Past experience in the required disciplines with TDOT and other clients
- Past experience specific to downtown streetscape and revitalization projects
- Qualification and availability of staff
- Demonstrated ability to meet schedule without compromising sound engineering practice.
- Evaluations on prior projects with TDOT and other clients, if available.
- Size of project.
- Amount of work under contract with TDOT and other clients.

From the letters of interest, the City of Parsons will select 3 qualified firms to submit Phase II qualifications. From this list the top ranked consultant will be selected.

## Phase II Evaluation

The City of Parsons will evaluate the top 3 firms on the following criteria (relative weight):

- a. Experience with TDOT Enhancement Projects (15%)
- b. Capacity to perform required work (15%)
- c. Knowledge of project and area (30%)
- d. Previous experience with agency projects and performance (40%)

The consultant evaluation committee holds the ability to conduct interviews based on scoring as Phase III Evaluation.
