- 2. Two (2) bidders' bid were not read aloud due to submitting combination bids that was not in compliance with the bid form process.
- 3. Two (2) Bidders submitted qualified bids, again not in compliance with the bid process.
- 4. One (1) bidder failed to include a bid bond and this is not in compliance with the bid process. This bid was read aloud unfortunately
- 5. One (1) bidder failed to sign their bid, and this is not compliance with bid form process. This bid was read aloud unfortunately.
