Community Forum-

A presentation from Pat Riley of Gibson County was presented to the City Council on natural gas as an alternate source of fuel for vehicles. Mr. Riley noted that natural gas is domestically produced and we did not have to depend on foreign countries for fuel. He also noted that Iran is the number one country using natural gas while the U.S ranks 80th. "We got a 200 year supply of natural gas, if not more" stated Mr. Riley. Parsons has already made the jump into the "clean green" energy source with the purchase of a CNG garbage truck, pick-up, and new patrol cars.

Alisa Gray with the Tennessee Department of Health-Volunteer Program also explained the state's volunteer program to the council. The state is asking for volunteers in order to build a data base as a resource in case of an emergency.
