Teresa Taylor, Chairman of the Recreation Committee gave an up-date. Parsons Regional Community Park is preparing to begin phase two of the development. Phase two 's plan will included a pavilion, playground and splash pad. The \$592,000 grant is 50/50 matching grant and 50% of the matching money can be in-kind such as excavation, topsoil, sod, and etc.

Lee Villaflor, Utility Supervisor, told city council members that Parsons' water was "high quality H2O" during his water presentation. After the on going problems in Flint Michigan, with their lead problems, Lee wanted to assure the public that the local water was definitely safe. Lee explained that the City of Parsons produces high quality water at an affordable rate. He presented a power point showing various awards that the water department has won over the past several years.
