A) COMMUNICATIONS FROM THE MAYOR:

- a. Mayor Boaz asked how tax sales are handled on properties that have several years of outstanding property taxes.
 - i. The law allows cities to collect property taxes for up to ten years. Delinquent taxes and potential tax sales are all handled by England Law Offices.
- B) **PROJECT UPDATES:** Lee Villaflor gave an update on the current projects.
 - a. <u>Blighted Home Project:</u> All but two houses are complete. Contractors have communicated with Lee that the demolition of these remaining houses will begin soon.
 - b. <u>ARP Sewer Project (Pipe Bursting)</u>: Construction is in progress and is estimated to be 95% completed.
 - c. ARP Water Plant Project (Drinking water): Vaults for control valves will be installed this week.
 - d. <u>TAM (Tennessee Association of Museums Grant (Municipal Building Roof Replacement)</u>: Roof replacement is 95% complete. Anticipate completion this week, weather permitting.
 - e. TDOT (Multimodal Grant): No new update
 - f. <u>2024 CDBG (Passive Park)</u>: Per Ginger, lead architect at TLM, will provide some entrance designs for the Parks and Rec Committee to approve. Soil testing in progress for pond.
 - g. PHMSA Gas Grant: No new update
 - h. SRF 4th St Lift Station: TDEC approved this project. No new updates.
 - i. <u>FEMA (2019 Hazardous Mitigation) Generator Grant</u>: Marsha Blackburn has a new representative in her office, maybe we will have a new update next month.
 - j. <u>USDA Truck grant</u>: No new updates.
