### REPORTS FROM COMMITTEES, COUNCILMEN, AND OTHER OFFICERS

#### A) COMMUNICATIONS FROM OTHER OFFICERS - POLICE DEPARTMENT:

Chief Woodward announced promotions of two PSO officers at this council meeting

- 1) Noah Poynter current rank, Lieutenant, being promoted to Captain
- 2) Michael Clickner current rank, Patrolman, being promoted to Investigator. He recently attended FTO class and is currently in the TBI Basic Investigator class.



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- B) **PROJECT UPDATES:** Lee Villaflor gave an update on the current projects.
  - a. ARP Sewer Project (Pipe Bursting): No new update
  - b. <u>ARP Water Plant Project (Drinking water)</u>: The tie into Beech River was completed Labor Day Weekend. We now have two feeds going south to Decaturville that will help feed Scotts Hill. Construction is finished, but now the engineers must finish their checklists and punch list to confirm that this project is completed.
  - c. TDOT (Multimodal Grant): Final ROW plans have been submitted to TDOT
  - d. 2024 CDBG (Passive Park): We met with TLM and landscape architect to finalize designs.
  - e. PHMSA Gas Grant: No new update
  - f. SRF 4th St Lift Station: No new update
  - g. FEMA (2019 Hazardous Mitigation) Generator Grant: No new update.
  - h. <u>USDA Truck grant</u>: All three remaining trucks are here! Two F-150's for the police department and one F-150 for the gas department were delivered this week. This completes all four trucks ordered in this grant.
  - i. <u>BCBS Healthy Place Grant</u>: Survey is completed with topography map for grant submittal. The grant award notification will be announced by December.

- A) Approve Resolution No. 09082025-01: A resolution Amending the Fiscal Year Budget 2025/2026
